Comments: The Nez Perce and Clearwater forests grow the equivalent of over 600 million board feet per year, but annually only 46 million board feet per year has been harvested on average. As a result, much of the forests have become overgrown and in need of treatment. According to the National Insect and Disease Risk Assessment, 65 percent of the Nez Perce-Clearwater - excluding wilderness and roadless areas- are at risk of wildfire, insects and disease. Between 1987 to 2017, approximately 53 percent of the national forest burned in wildfires. Hopefully this can be taken into consideration and revised. Thank you, Steve
