Comments: The current Hoodoo RWA acreage should be re classified as semi-primitive motorized. Access would be limited to snowmobiles, snow bikes and mountain bikes. Only 20,000 of the 200,00 acres in this area are compatible with snowmobiling, and when the snow melts they leave no trace. Snowmobiling was allowed in this area and should be open again. As for wildlife mountain goats can't survive in snow deeper than 2 feet as they feed on grasses and lichens and low growing shrubs. Forest Service studies have shown that goats are more scared of skiers than snowmobiles. IT is my feeling that the Great Burn should again be opened to snowmobiling. I make these comments knowing full well that it will make no difference as the Forest Service has already predetermined the outcome as they always do.
