I support a semi-primitive motorized designation for this area instead of a RWA. Limiting access to snowmobiles, snowbikes, and mountain bikes only. However I do support protection of the Great Burn from any activity(s) that could impair the character of the area. In my opinion, the great burn area offers an opportunity for snowmobiling, and snowbiking that is unmatched anywhere in the lower 48. As a snowmobiler, I enjoy the same scenery, challenging topography, and the solitude that non motorized users enjoy in this area. When the snow melts there is no trace of snowmobiles even being in the area. Before the Great Burn was designated a RWA I used to snowmobile the area.
