I am writing to urge you to leave all 89 streams that you have found eligible for Wild and Scenic designation remain protected as eligible in the new forest plan. There is widespread support for their designation, among Idaho and Montana residents, and among Americans across the country. The draft plan eliminating these protections fails to consider the voices of these many Americans who recreate and find solitude on these rivers, including mine. Moreover, the draft plan blatantly and plainly fails to consider both the present and future economy of the region. Outdoor recreation is a massive economic driver of both the Idaho and Western Montana regions. The draft plan is short sighted. We can do better than this.

The range of alternatives is too narrow. The plan should consider protecting every single stream as an alternative.
