Comments: I have recently reviewed the released Nez Perce-Clearwater Forest Plan Revision Draft Environmental Impact Statement and Draft Revised Forest Plan. None of the alternatives presented reflect the management I would like to see implemented for the Hoodoo Roadless Area. Please accept these comments into the formal record.

I am avid user of the wilderness. I have been exploring the Great Burn area for over sixteen years. Sixteen years ago this spring, I helped restore a lot of the hiking trails in the Great Burn with Montana Conservation Corps. It would be a shame to allow motorized vehicles in the Great Burn. The mountain goat population is already at risk, among other wildlife. The noise pollution alone would be traumatic. Please keep the Great Burn a roadless area!

I believe the entire 151,874 should be managed as recommended wilderness!

Snowmobiles will wreck havoc on the wildlife and the noise pollution will be a huge annoyance for non-motorized users.

I'm not too familiar with these creeks, but I don't see why they wouldn't be classified as wild or scenic.
