None of the alternatives presented reflect the management I would like to see implemented for the Hoodoo Roadless Area. Please accept these comments into the formal record.

In my retirement, I travel widely for bird photography. I greatly value all lands kept in their natural state, especially roadless areas.

I would like to visit the Great Burn area to experience its natural beauty.

I would like to have the entire Hoodoo Roadless Area to be managed as Recommended Wilderness. We can not have too much wilderness!

All of the Hoodoo Roadless area should be off-limits to motorized vehicles, which are incompatible with the concept (and definition) of wilderness.

Rivers to be recognized as Wild and Scenic should include Cayuse Creek and Kelly Creek (including its forks).

As you develop these plans and polices, please adhere to the definition of true Wilderness.
