None of the alternatives presented reflect the management I would like to see implemented for the Hoodoo Roadless Area. Please accept these comments into the formal record.

I moved to Montana for the beauty and openness. There are so many places in our country that are civilised and motorised. Please do not shrink the Great Burn Recommended Wilderness. Please do not allow motorized and mechanized use. These changes would have huge negative implications for quiet recreation and might be devastating for sensitive wildlife species, including wolverines and mountain goats.

I haven't had the chance to go to the Great Burn yet. But I've seen it and talked to people and look forward to my first experience - hiking and camping and taking photographs.

Please preserve the entire Hoodoo Roadless Area as Recommended Wilderness.

Please do not allow winter motorised access. Snowmobiles are disruptive of wildlife and personal enjoyment for miles and miles. Again, there are so many places that snowmobilers can go, please preserve our wilderness areas.

Please keep the Cayuse Creek, Kelly Creek and all of its forks Wild and Scenic. They are so pristine and beautiful!

Please make your forest plan as comprehensive as possible to include safe migration paths as well.
