Comments: I have recently reviewed the released Nez Perce-Clearwater Forest Plan Revision Draft Environmental Impact Statement and Draft Revised Forest Plan. None of the alternatives presented reflect the management I would like to see implemented for the Hoodoo Roadless Area. Please accept these comments into the formal record.

I am a Montana resident and I urge you to keep the Great Burn wild and non-motorized. As our world gets warmer, more polluted and more crowded, we need to do all we can to preserve the few remaining, unprotected wild places like the Hoodoo Roadless Area.

This beautiful corner to Montana should be preserved for future generations and for the health of the ecosystem.

I would like to see the Hoodoo Roadless Area continue to be managed as Recommended Wilderness.

Allowing motorized access to portions of the Hoodoo Roadless Area will negatively impact the wilderness character of the area and will likely result in increased illegal incursions into the areas that are closed to motorized.

I believe the forest plan should recognize Cayuse Creek, as well as Kelly Creek and all of its forks as Wild and Scenic.
