As a former employee of the US Forest Service and a native Montanan, I have spent many years of my life benefitting from the state's wild and protected areas. We must work hard to protect the undeveloped areas we have left - for future generations, for wildlife, for the sake of these places themselves. Thank you immensely for your consideration.

I ask you to consider protecting the entire 151,874-acre Hoodoo Roadless Area - and I hope that it continues to be managed as Recommended Wilderness.

I strongly suggest that the Forest Service continue to designate the Hoodoo Roadless Area as non-motorized. There are so many areas open to motorized vehicles, and so few protected for hikers/backpackers, wildlife, and ecosystems to exist without the hum of cars, snowmobiles, ATVs. There is nothing quite like the solace of being deep in the wilderness without the sound of a motor to be heard.

I recommend the forest plan recognize Cayuse Creek and Kelly Creek and all of its forks as Wild and Scenic.
