I have ridden the historic Great Burn snowmobile area for many years. In that period of time I have not seen any sign of environmental damage from snowmobiling. The snow is extremely deep. I have never seen anyone other than a snowmobiler back in the Great Burn so there is obviously no conflict with other users. In my years of riding in the Great Burn I have never seen a goat. The riders that I have talked to that have seen goats say they are indifferent to our presence.
