I support getting rid of the RWA status of the Hoodoo Area and changing it to a semi primitive motorized area. So historical snowmobile use can continue in the Hoodoo Area.

The semi primitive motorized area should allow snowmobiles and snowbikes in the winter time and Mtn. bikes in the summer. Sneakfoot Meadows and Northfork Spruce - White Sands RWA's should also be eliminated. Under the semi primitive motorized designation the Hoodoo Area stays the same size as it is today.
