Any further expansion for Purgatory should address the resorts failure to develop an effective uphill ski policy and allow citizens to recreate on this terrain during the ski season. The resort is located on USFS land that is owned by the American taxpayer. Purgatory has not responded to requests for development of a policy. This is despite the increased popularity of uphill skiing. Any of Aspen Ski Company's policies for Ajax, Snowmass, Highlands and Buttermilk should and could be adopted and implemented at Purgatory. Purgatory is one of the few remaining resorts in Colorado that do not allow any form of in season uphill skiing.
