I personally work in local habitat restoration in Whatcom and Skagit County, a majority of my work being managing noxious weeds on logging lands. Not only do logging impacts immediately disrupt and remove critical wildlife habitat (even if it is to be considered sustainable logging practices), these practices are a threat and certainly impose long term impacts that must be managed and mitigated for for the lifetime of the logging practices. Noxious weeds like knotweed are already a huge issue on systems like the SF Nooksack. Logging trucks can be vectors for noxious weeds like scotch broom and knotweed.
