To cite the Orca Recovery Task Force, watersheds that "Should be evaluated and prioritized where juvenile Chinook production could be increased in the very near term. Estuaries called out include Nooksack, Skagit, Stillaguamish, Elwha, Dungeness, Snohomish, Green-Duwamish, Puyallup, Nisqually..."
