I have spent many many years of my life fishing and recreating along the Canyon creek watershed and volunteering with NSEA and know how fragile the ecosystem is. Logging and over fishing has ruined our salmon run as well as our other anadromous fish migrations. We are working an already touchy return of salmon to the hatchery and risking damage to vital spawning areas seems like a ridiculous proposal. Canyon creek also provides a large ammount of traffic and business to the town of Glacier and further logging risks exacerbating the problem of road washouts and land slides that historically closes the road.

Other than those complaints, we also rely on our lush forests to trap carbon. New roads and traffic on those roads promote invasive species and forest fires.
