Comments: Logging in the North Fork Nooksack River and its tributaries just off the Mt. Baker Scenic Byway threatens to turn our green backyard into a pulp farm for Trumps business cronies. Maintaining this part of the Mt. Baker Snoqualmie National Forest is critical to both our regional ecosystems and human. Logging these forests defeats their carbon sequestration potential for decades to come.

Logging of this scale is a radical departure from previous Forest Service management direction and requires an EIS.
