Comments: I am specifically concerned about the Forest Service classing mechanized use as suitable in primate areas outside of the specific Wilderness designations. Part of the attraction and special function of being in the forest is the ability to actually hear nature at its most basic, including the luxury of near silence. Mechanical usage will completely disrupt that possibility with the loud motor noises which will scare off any wildlife and negatively impact the experience of other users for miles around.

I request that mechanized use be severely restricted to all primitive areas in order to retain their large, remote, wild values.
