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Comments: I would like to make a comment against most, if not all of this current proposal. My first and biggest issue with this is that the ski resort is wanting to expand the mountain capacity without even addressing the parking problem! This proposal states that parking will not be impacted, but this just isn't true, with more capacity and more visitors there will definitely need to be more, and better parking. Who is going to want to come ski on a mountain that then takes a long time to get to the lifts after parking? I also do not think expanding into Fish Creek Canyon is a good idea. There are many moose, raptors, bears, and other wild animals that take shelter in that area during the winter in order to get away from all the skiers. The impact to these animals will be more than just the construction or skiers going by, there will be snowmobiles, avalanche bombing, etc taking place and where will these animals go? The mitigation plan for the raptors doesn't even protect them during construction, or maintenance, or future progress, so it's basically just a farce. In addition, many people ski into Fish Creek out of the access gates and getting back onto the mountain is fairly easy. Opening up the terrain in Fish Creek will then push back country skiers even farther out, making potential rescue situations even more difficult than the current situation. It is such a widely used "side country" that I think it will be really hard to enforce to skiers when, and where they are allowed to ski in this area. I am also concerned about what these changes will do to the summer time access and enjoyability of Fish Creek? Back to the mountain and the new proposed gondola. The trajectory of the proposed gondola seems like an eye sore! The mountain is already so crowded, I don't think that ski corp needs to get more people up quicker as some of the runs are already dangerously packed! I do think it is a good idea to get people out of the base area quicker and the already approved section of the gondola up to Bashor would be useful. This way families/ski schoolers can go that way, while the die hard skiers can take the current gondola. Finally, adding more snow making is just using up more resources, water, electricity, and creating more noise pollution. Taking into account all the aspects, visual, our natural resources and the wild animals, this proposal seems like it will have damaging, long lasting impacts to our forest.
