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Comments: I strongly oppose the proposed Forest Plan Amendment to allow for harvesting of trees larger than 21 inches in diameter. More logging will degrade forest ecosystems by reducing biodiversity, removing biomass, destroying wildlife habitat, degrading soils, creating erosion issues, increasing threats of invasive species, and creating unnecessary, harmful, and unsightly disturbances. The scientific basis and justification for this project is skewed towards economic values verses ecological values. The public will benefit far more from preserving these trees and forests rather than implementing unnecessary, costly, and destructive management policies that will only serve to benefit a few private interests over the larger interests of the public and ecosystem health and viability.
