Comments: The upper basins of Hyalite and Storm Castle lying on either side of Divide Peak in the Gallatin Range are pristine alpine meadows that support a variety of iconic and sensitive wildlife species including Grizzly Bears, mule deer , mountain goats and bighorn sheep. These two basins should be included as wilderness not only to protect those species but also to protect the crystal clear streams that flow from them to feed downstream waters. Motorized access to these high elevation basins must be halted to stop the destructive impacts it has on trails leading to them before the expected future increase of motorized use destroys them forever.
