Closing the road for several months does not seem to be necessary. What is needed is some way to emplant a reduction in the speed of vehicles using the road. Possibly putting water diversion bars in the road would help facilitate this and reduce the amount of dust being produced. The parking at the berm is needed along with the parking provided by this project.
