Comments: I am a Permittee & Land owner adjacent to the HDs. The HDs are designated wildness area and provide the natural migration for Elk & Deer annually. Although adversely effected by the drought it still provides an abundance of forage for wildlife & grazing. There is currently a off road trail from Hayden Creel to Sauls creek which has severed as a fire break road during the many Prescribed Burns in the recent past. It was impossible on your map to see the location of the proposed OHV fire line proposed. Additional roads only change the migration patterns already stressed!

My recommendation would be to allow increased grazing allotment for time and animal units. The cattle move to higher ground late in the season and reach areas not reached before, this can be managed to obtain the goal of forage overgrowth.
