I believe eBikes should be allowed on federal lands/trails but this access should be limited to Class 1 & Delieve everyone on the trails with an eBike should only be using Class 1 bikes, but I understand there are some disabled people that could only participate if Class 2 bikes were included. There is no need for someone to be using the faster, 28 MPH assisted bike on trails. The people who are of the mindset that would desire to go faster than 20 MPH on trails are exactly the type of people that will likely abuse this privilege, anger other trail users and severely degrade public opinion toward the eBiking community.
