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Comments: Please do not not repeal the 21 inch rule, protecting large and old trees. Fewer and fewer large trees exist in our forests. We know they are important for carbon storage, cooling forest understories, and providing habitat to wildlife. This repeal seems like just another excuse to log big trees. Now, because the Forest Service logged so many big old ponderosa and Doug fir trees, they are coming for the less desirable but large grand firs under the guise of them being fire intolerant and inhibiting the growth of new more desirous tree species. As noted before, there is always an excuse for getting out the cut. At the very least, please prepare an EIS. This decision will clearly have significant impacts on our forests and their plants and wildlife.
