- 1. E-bikes must be regarded as motor vehicles and can travel only where such vehicles can travel.
- 2. This rule has environmental impacts which must be evaluated under an EIS under NEPA.
- 3. There are likely some conflicts with the Forest Service' Travel Management Rule 36 CFR 212 et seq.
- 4. With the speed and quiet nature of e-bikes, they can travel back further into the backcountry, likely disturbing wildlife, hikers, horseback riders and bicyclists.
- 5. E-bikes will likely trespass into the wilderness and protected areas with no consequences. This will degrade the wild character of these areas which is unacceptable.
- 6. We feel the Forest Services should withdraw this proposal.
