New e-bikes are being developed that will drive up to 55 mph. This will have catastrophic impacts on other trail users like hikers, horseback riders, and bicyclists.

There is almost no enforcement now for trespass, illegal off-trail riding, and illegal trail development by some bikers, e-bikes will increasingly trespass into Wilderness and other protected areas with no consequences.
