Comments: I am a senior citizen who does not want e-bikes. All motorized vehicles should not be allowed on National Forest trails.

An estimated 60,000 miles of US Forest Service trails are already open to e-bike use. Across all public lands, millions of miles of roads and motorized trails are open to e-bikes. Why needlessly expand access?

Motorized bikes travel further and faster into the backcountry. Traveling up to 20-30 mph, e-bikes disrupt wildlife, impact habitat, and ruin the small portion of public lands that are quietly free from motorized vehicles.

Allowing e-bikes will increase trail use and the likelihood of reckless off-trail travel, further impacting ecosystems and causing erosion.
