Comments: Generally speaking, I do not approve of use of eBikes on trails that can travel faster than 15 mph , which would be speed that falls into the median speed that most individual ride. There are few riders that can average 20 mph on trails, so there is no reason to allow eBike users to ride at a faster rate of speed. Riders are already creating alternative routes to avoid present obstacles (cutting out trees, roots, etc.) to ride faster. Higher rates of speed will also increase the amount of erosion that occurs and most of these riders will not participate in trail management.
