Comments: I would like to see that Class 1 pedal assist Ebikes are allowed on public lands, BLM operated lands, National forest and any other lands where bicycles are allowed. Class 1 Ebikes or pedal assist, are not self propelled. One must pedal in order for the assist to take place. There is no throttle or other device to propel the bike other than leg power. The pedal assist is just that. It reduces the amount of effort needed to pedal. Sort of like shifting your gears to a lower gear to reduce the amount of effort to ride up a hill. A pedal assist Ebike is just like riding a non assisted bike. It will not move unless you are pedaling and is also governed so any assist is stopped at 20 MPH. With the realization that if one can pedal up to 20 MPH they do not need pedal assist anymore. Please consider allowing pedal assist Class 1 Ebikes to be used on these public lands. Thank you. Bill D.
