Any time access is proposed on a multi-use trail, hikers and equestrians lose a non-motorized trail and their funding sources too!

It doesn't align with the new rule that the Department of Interior agencies recently adopted, adding to consumer confusion on where eMTBs can go.

Locally, eMTB access on Forest Service trails would not align with Washington state law, which classifies e-bikes as non-motorized.
