We don't pedal for speed, 6-10 mph is our norm. We respect hikers, and others. Opening trails to ebikes allows access for people like us. They are pedal assist and not designed so that they will tear up the trails like an actual motor cycle or 4 wheeler would. They are NOT motor vehicles they are bikes that help older people to remain active and able to take in our natural resources and enjoy them. Please consider treating them differently than motor vehicles. Max speeds can be set in the controls so they can be adjusted to suit a speed limit, etc. They are not destructive to trails any more than a non powered bicycle.
