They are definitely not enjoying the sights. Add an electric motor to that bike and increase the speed to upwards of 35mph. Now you have a moving object that is fast and silent. Most likely the horse will spook, possibly bolt and the rider will end up on the ground and injured. Possibly the two will collide and both will be injured.
