Comments: Permitting e-bikes on USFS trails is a life changing decision for many older individuals.

Allow all e-bikes (classes 1-3) onto USFS trails and monitor the interactions between e-bikes and hikers, joggers, horses, and non-electric bicycles, for six months to one year. Stipulate the right-of-way rules in advance. Use ticketing, fining, and banning enforcement for any e-bike rider that does not follow the posted right-of-way rules during, and after, this test assessment period.

At the end of the monitored test period, publish the data collected by USFS, and make a determination to allow or prohibit all e-bikes on trails BASED ON THE USFS DATA COLLECTED.

Any process other than scientific data based assessment will incorporate people's biases, egos, monitory greed, soapbox preaching, selfish exclusion, organizational prejudice, immaturity, and disinformation into the decision process.
