Comments: Thank you for the opportunity for the public to engage on FSM 7700 and 7710, which would revise Forest Service directives to update and clarify guidance on management of electric bicycle (e-bike) use on National Forest System lands.

The final directive must reconsider how to allow class 1 eMTBs on select non-motorized trails while retaining a trail's non-motorized status, similar to the recent Department of Interior final rule. The final directive can be further improved by following the International Mountain Bicycling Association's management recommendations: managing the three classes of e-bikes separately from one another, and prohibiting class 2 and class 3 eMTBs on natural surface, non-motorized trails.

The recent growth of e-bikes allows new individuals to allow the trails responsibly, however, not all of them are the same. Similar directives should also provide guidance regarding the use of motorized scooters and boards. If allowing all motorized bikes, scooters, boards, or none, it would be best to defer to none.
