Comments: In my experience of horseback riding on trails open for all public use, pedal bike riders have always watched for other users and called out to horse riders to alert them. The possibility of an e-bike rider coming upon horse riders faster than they can alert the horse riders can result in a startled horse. That can result in the horse making a sudden sideways bolt capable of unseating the rider, with a painful impact with the ground. I recommend restricting the use of e-bikes to the forest roads available to pedal bikes because of the greater visibility of all users.
