Comments: I vigorously oppose the opening of non-motorized trails to e-bike use. Adding a group of users that require (want) motorized bikes is simply a bad idea and compounds existing problems with pedestrian, horse and bike use of trails. I personally try to avoid such trails because the experience of nature is significantly degraded by biker activity. Very few bikers observe the "rules of the trail" and speed through hikers expecting hikers to "jump". Too often I have encountered riders that DO NOT have the skills to be on "open space" trails let alone backcountry trails. They are dangerous. Further, it is easy to observe that trails frequented by bikers become braided as many riders, where possible, seek to avoid roots and rocks exposed by rapid erosion. In my opinion adding motorized e-bikes to these trails is asking for major problems and conflicts.
