Comments: I am opposed to wide spread use of ebikes on mountain bike trails. Their use is likely to cause increased wear on trails both due to increased speed as well as ability to session more trails. This may cause increased erosion and increased maintenance costs. Increased speed poses a safety issue both for some riders who may not have the skill to handle this as well as pose a danger to other users. Electronic motorized bikes are not different than gas motorized bikes. There are plenty of ohv designated ride areas. There are many trails that already allow motorized bikes and from my experience riding mountain bikes on these trails is that they tend to be more rutted, washed out or eroded. On uphill trails there are more spin out potholes making it more difficult for analog bikes. In short, wide spread use of e-bikes would increase user conflict, increase risk, increase destruction of trail surfaces, increase maintenance costs. Just say no to e-bikes. I already see e-bikes on trails that are clearly posted no e-bikes; without clear restriction and enforcement of motorized vehicle use, their illegal use will flourish.
