Comments: Direct loss of Chinook salmon habitat over all alternatives: 3.3-4.2 miles lost, or 20.8-26%. This is a significant loss of habitat for a threatened species listed under the Endangered Species Act. This loss is not specifically mitigated in the DEIS, only generally mentioned in Mitigation Appendix D.
