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Comments: Voice you Opposition for the Stibnite Gold Project. The Stibnite Gold Project is a lose-lose for Idaho. Midas Gold intends to nearly triple the footprint of the historic mine area, using three open-pit mines and cyanide leaching to extract gold and antimony in the headwaters of one of Idaho's most iconic waterways: The Salmon River. It would be one of the largest gold mines in the country, and it would do irreparable damage to surrounding ecosystems and river-centric recreation. The proposed project will destroy 20% of critical habitat for chinook and bull trout, and 75% of the project disturbance would occur on public land. This project is the opposite of what Idaho needs right now. For these reasons I oppose and urge denial of the Stibnite Gold Project. Idaho's ground is worth more than what's in it.
