Comments: The breadth of the Twisp Restoration project in scale, scope, needs to meet and interested parties is massive. The expected timeline for implementation is long. The comment period is short. To fully appreciate all the implications for a project of this scale takes significant time and attention. Human ability to predict our impact on forests has been proven wrong repeatedly. Community consensus on short and long term goals for this area and how we can best achieve those goals based on the known science will require thought and education. Different parts of the community have different goals and needs but without bringing those forward for discussion the Forest Service is guaranteed to disappoint everyone. Also it is critical that it be possible to change course as new information comes to light. I would like to see additional community discussion and review over the next 4 months with site visits to areas in the early spring of particularly sensitive areas, and a staged approach to the project that allows for redirection and correction as the Forest Service moves forward.
