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Comments: I would like to comment on the Twisp Restoration Project. (1)Rigorous scientific study of salvage logging operations in Oregon confirm that overall forest health in burned areas are WORSE if logged after fire. Delete salvage logging option. (2) This is a forest health/restoration project, lets look at ATV use in the trails project. (3)The inclusion of the cutting of trees up to 30" in diameter seems to be at odds with FS own policy of not cutting trees over 20" in diameter, and the projects own comment on the scarcity of larger trees. Cut no trees over 20". (4)With such a large project being rolled out in 5 phases, why not have public comment periods prior to each major phase?

Lets have more and therefore better informed public comment before each 5 phases.(5)I think it makes more sense to have no roadbuilding in existing roadless areas or old growth areas as they now exist. If fire risk thinning needs to be done near these areas it should only happen on the very perimeter and without road building.
