Comments: To whom it may concern,

I urge you to halt any further progress on the Twisp River Restoration Project until a full Environmental Impact Statement is completed.

The scope is far too large to be under only one project and should be divided up into many smaller projects, each with their own EIS and comment period. While being a 30 year project, dividing it up into smaller projects would allow it to be reviewed as time progresses and we develop more knowledge from research on how best to care for forests at risk for wildfires.

While I support efforts to help prevent wildland fires, this project does not follow the optimal Fire Management science, nor the Forest Service's own Restoration Strategies.

Traffic from ATVs and logging trucks up the very rural and quiet Twisp River Road will have an impact on wildlife and humans and should be evaluated more fully.
