Comments: I cannot tell from the document if the Harris Park shooting range is going to remain open or closed. I can see one page noting the kinds of shooting that will be permitted and I can also see a chart where the area is shaded as "Previously Closed" or closed. I also read the observations on pollution, but "noise" pollution was not mentioned. The Harris Park range is notorious for trash left behind, trees shot up, fires, and enormous cannon like explosives reverberating off the surrounding mountainsides that can be heard ten miles away. What makes Harris Park somewhat distinct versus the other shooting ranges is 1). Over a thousand people living within 1-4 miles of the echoing explosions (The surrounding slopes act like a perfect and amplifying echo chamber) and 2) Another two/three thousand residents that can hear the booming cacophony from 5-10 miles away (I live 6/7 miles away and hear even the smallest of gunfire), and 3). The peace of the nearby/bordering Mount Evans National Wilderness (and other nearby Pike National Forest hiking trails) is shattered/overwhelmed by the constant gunfire at the Harris Park range. This should not be for a Wilderness Area. On December 26th, 2020 I was hiking in the forest north of the range and climbing rocks for a lunchtime snack. Someone at the range decided to shoot up into the trees in my direction. I heard the scream of the bullet above me just before it snapped a tree branch. Combined, for the sake of thousands who live in the area of the Harris Park shooting range, please close it down. Thank-you for this option to provide comments.
