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Comments: This is a follow-up to a previous query concerning the Scattered Lands Project and the Horn Mtn area which was initially in the targeted project area. My understanding of why Horn Mtn was "dropped" from the project was not that it did not warrant remediation for lack of fuels, but rather for lack of access. After further discussions, Horn Mtn does require attention as it possesses a high density of fuels and stocking levels. The designated method of treatment is "hand" treatment, implicating that "foot" access is sufficient or all that is necessary. "Foot" traffic provides for a reduced impact on neighboring private land and is much preferred over the effects caused by large equipment. It is my opinion that private landowners would be more amenable to permitting this kind of access and disturbance. Multiple access points would hasten treatment and I for one, am willing to discuss this probability. I highly recommend that Scattered Lands Project leaders reach out to neighboring Horn Mtn landowners for comment and potential access to an area that needs treatment. Thank you!
