It should not be there, because that side of the mountain should be reserved for wilderness, forest resource, day use recreation and camping only. But since it is there, I am all the more aware of the negative impacts of human activities on the mountain. I do not support further development of ski or recreation areas, parking or lodging on that side of the mountain. I do support the CleanSweep land swap that has been in the works for several decades. The under-valuation of the Government Camp property is not realistic, given its potential for development, while the over-valuation of the property owned by Mt Hood Meadows, above Highway 35, is only because there is an assumption that development there would eventually be allowed.
