Whatever you do, please do not adopt Alternative 1, or any other Alternative that involves clearcutting.

Clearcutting negatively impacts climate change, salmon habitat and landslide/erosion.

The Forest Service should not be clearcutting in the 21st century.

The Canyon Creek Watershed has already been adversely impacted by logging, as clearly documented by the USFS Watershed Analysis for the basin.

Mount Baker Ranger District should be advancing selective thinning rather than clearcutting to meet its ecological goals and responsibilities.

Clearcut-plantation forestry degrades water quality and destroys salmon habitat by increasing the rate of erosion and landslides. Clearcutting makes water move faster through the hydrologic system, which means there is too much water in the winters and too little water in the summers.
