I was happy to see some improvement in the Environmental Assessment for the North Fork Nooksack Vegetation Project. However, I remain concerned about misleading and improper identification of riparian reserves, and do not have faith that the short-term impacts of "Variable Retention Harvest" will not have lasting detrimental impact.

With this in mind, I would urge you to adopt Alternative 2 with the modification of better identification and treatment of riparian reserves.

We know what will happen if these riparian areas are destroyed and abused: just look at the Stillaguamish River. The potential for landslides, mudslides and other erosion events is far too great.

I have confidence that you will do the right thing for the North Fork Nooksack, and everyone who depends on that river and watershed remaining healthy.
