Comments: The fact that the Sandia Peak Ski Area Mountain Coaster Project (#56985) might circumvent an environmental assessment or environment impact statement should be the first red flag. The Sandia Mountain ecosystem is a sensitive one, and any proposal for a project as different from the typical uses of a national park should seriously consider environmental impacts. If not from the construction itself, then from the noise and increased foot traffic. Additionally, there is the worry of forest fires: more foot traffic means more chances for an inadvertent forest fire to start, and as Sandia Peak readily admits they want to attract visitors who "enjoy more passive recreation experiences" than mountain biking or hiking, there is a chance that some of these visitors will be less well-versed in fire prevention than those who hike or camp. Sandia Peak should seek other, less intrusive ways to drum up business. And finally (although it should be weighted more heavily), no party has even reached out for feedback from the Tiwa people, to whom Sandia Mountain is sacred.
