It has come to my attention that the Forest Service has not allowed wild horses their fair share of public land grazing, but has allowed an inordinate amount of cow-calf pairs to use these lands. I ask that the ratio of horses be changed to exceed, or at least be equal to, the number of cattle allowed. I do not want my tax dollars to go toward cheap grazing leases for cattle and the removal (and highly uncertain fate) of wild horses.

I also have read that horses have been hunted, shot and killed on these lands. This is despicable and heinous, and those people should be caught and prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

I encourage the use of humane fertility control methods in the wild horse population.
