First territory boundaries are not in accordance with The Wild Free Roaming Horse and Burro act 1971. Instead the Forest Service did not do surveys before mapping lines for the Heber Wild Horses territory. Due to cattle pasture leasing fences are now up on these public lands. The fences prevent free roaming of the Wild Horses for water, forage and shelter. This should be a time when you truly show up and do what is best and humane for these horse. You the Forest Service are supposed to be protecting them, NOT a voice for the cattleman.
